Reminders:

Please remember the uniform policy. All students must either be in the royal blue or yellow HFA: Elementary embroidered shirts with navy blue pants or skirts/skorts (no jumpers) for girls. If you are waiting for your uniform shirt to arrive your child must wear a white shirt and navy blue pants.
